FIFA Laws of the Game are adamant that no jewellery may be worn whilst playing soccer for safety reasons. In the spirit of the game, players should not be prohibited from playing soccer due to the fact that they are required to wear a Medical Alert bracelet. Medical Alert bracelets may be worn as a Velcro sports bracelet or a shoe tag both of which are permissible under Law 4 provided that they do not constitute a danger to the wearer or other players. If the player only has a stainless steel bracelet, this must be covered up with a sweat band to meet the requirement of Law 4.
